

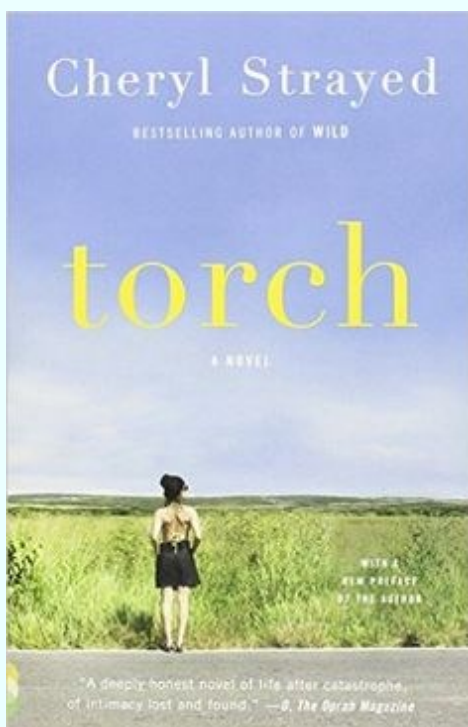
Be Part of an Amazing Book Club
